

## Do any of these describe your child?

- Seems weaker or clumsier than peers, tires easily
- Reluctant to play on playground equipment
- Difficulty drawing/coloring/copying/cutting
- Poor pencil grasp
- Has difficulty understanding and following directions
- Overstimulated in loud or busy environments
- Sensitive to touch
- Sensitive to loud or unexpected noises
- Sensitive to lights
- Dislikes being messy
- Dislikes haircuts/hair washing/nail cutting
- Aggressive with others
- Does not accept changes in routine easily
- Always “on the go”
- Constantly jumping or climbing (impulsive)
- Has no fear or decreased safety awareness
- Decreased functional communication skills
- Trouble with handwriting
- Mouths/licks non-food items
- Drooling
- Very picky eater
- Overstuffs mouth when eating
- Difficulty calming down after a tantrum
